9. What is the scientific name of the white-sided dolphin?

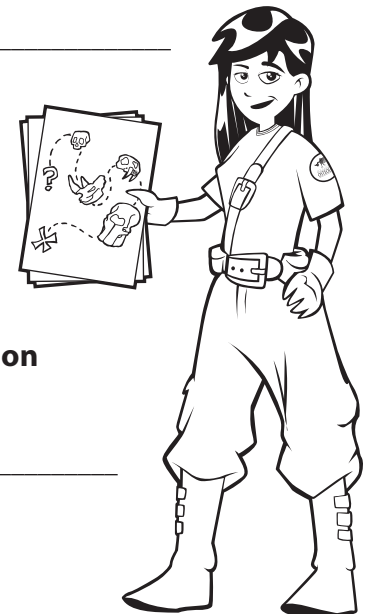
10. What does the killer whale skeleton have that the humpback whale skeleton does not?
